Course Description:

This course is designed to teach the student basic accounting principles, including: understanding forms and reports, understanding tax forms and preparation, and giving the student the ability to run his/her own small business.

Credit Requirements:

Credit will be allowed for students who: **1)** Watch all 9 Videos. **2)** Complete all assignments and tests when due and according to the standards set by the instructor. **3)** Complete the Accounting Game Workbook.

Grading:

Students taking the class for credit will be graded using the following criteria: **45%** of the grade is based upon class attendance, participation, reading and homework, **30%** mid-term & final exam, and **25%** of the grade is based upon the final project (Completion of Accounting Game Workbook).

Grading Points Detailed Breakdown:

250 points = Project: The Accounting Game (25 points for each of 10 chapters)

300 points = Midterm Exam (125 points), Final Exam (175 points)

450 points = Reading 13 Chapters and completing assignments (30 points/Chapter), viewing 9 Videos (5 points/Video), completing QSU Log (15 total points)
